This very moving monument in Oberursel commemorates the town's residents who fell victim to the Nazi regime. The monument was built in stages as it was entirely financed by voluntary donations and fundraising. Its construction was managed by a community group of volunteers and was finally completed this year. It was formally handed over to the town of Oberursel on 3 September. The Mayor and Mayoress of Rushmoor were present for this important occasion as was the Deputy Chief Executive of Rushmoor Borough Council and partner.

**St Michael's Abbey, Farnborough**— a Benedictine abbey containing the mausoleum of Napoleon III, his wife Empress Eugenie and their son, Prince Imperial. There is also a very rare Cavaille-Coll organ which you can hear being played at concerts on Sunday afternoons in the summer.

The Abbey is also open to visitors on Saturday afternoons and it is well worth a visit. A very famous piece of French history hidden away in Farnborough.

'It was good to watch all of the people join in with our songs.' Emily




'My favourite part of the trip was bonding; every year group socialised and we are all so much closer. My least favourite part was trying to fit everything back in my suitcase!' Jess
